Luminda Duggan, Midland

Services for Luminda Duggan, 97, of Midland will be at 2 p.m. Friday at West Side Church of Christ. Graveside rites will be at 11 a.m. Saturday in Alameda Cemetery in Eastland under direction of Newnie W. Ellis Funeral Home.

Mrs. Duggan died Tuesday in a Midland hospital.

She was born Sept. 5, 1881, in Tennessee and moved to Texas when she was 2 years old. She married William Emitt Duggan on March 12, 1899 in Eastland County. He preceded her in death in 1941.
