Mrs. Patterson Dies at Age 69

RANGER (RNS) — Mrs. E.B. (Jennie Ann) Patterson, 69, a resident of Olden for the past 33 years and a resident of Eastland County for 50 years, died in Stamford Memorial Hospital at 7:20 p.m. Saturday.

Funeral will be at 2:30 p.m. Monday in First Baptist Church in Olden with the Rev. Clyde Cook, pastor of Aspermont's First Baptist Church, and the Rev. Bob Farrell, pastor of Olden First Baptist Church, officiating.

Burial will be in Alameda Cemetery under direction of Killingsworth Funeral Home. Nephews will serve as pallbearers. The body will be at Olden First Baptist Church from noon to service time Monday.

She was born Sept. 10, 1897, in Farmersville, the former Jennie Ann Herrell. She married Elzie B. Patterson, Jan. 23, 1916, in the Alameda Community.
