Ranger girl dies after accident

A 17-year-old girl died Wednesday after her car struck another vehicle head-on just south of Ranger on Sunday on Farm-to-Market Road 2461, authorities said.

Reva Jo Huston of Ranger died at Harris Methodist Hospital in Fort Worth, according to a report from the Texas Department of Public Safety.

Huston was southbound when her 1990 Toyota crossed into the northbound lane, where Barbara Caraway, 54, a Ranger homemaker, was traveling, authorities said. Troopers are still investigating the cause of the accident.

Caraway, who had been wearing a seat belt while driving her 1999 Plymouth van, was taken to Hendrick Medical Center in Abilene. She is listed in serious condition with internal injuries. Huston had not worn her seat belt.
