J. H. Fox, Pioneer Eastland County Ranchman, Dies

RANGER, Oct. 15. — John Henry Fox, 74, pioneer Eastland County rancher died at 3:45 Friday afternoon after suffering a heart attack at his home here.

Mr. Fox was born in Knoble, Ark., but came to Texas with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. John Cornelius Fox. The family settled in Eastland County and engaged in extensive stock farming and ranching.

Survivors include three daughters, Mrs. Ada Webb, Odessa; Mrs. Glenn Williams, Monahans; and Mrs. Thelma Crabb, Ranger; and four sons, Wesley of Holliday, Louis of Wichita Falls, Hibert of Odessa, and Thomas of Ranger; and three brothers, G. L. Fox, Chief Deputy Sheriff of Taylor County, C. V. Fox, Fort Worth; and Thomas Fox, Ranger.

Funeral arrangements are incomplete. Burial will be at Alameda Cemetery with Killingsworth Funeral Home in charge.
