

## **Mrs. Green Dies at 97**

RANGER (RNS) - Mrs. Emma Frances Green, 97, a resident of the Chaney community south of Ranger from 1900 until moving to Ranger nine years ago, died at 5:50 p.m. Thursday in Ranger General Hospital.

She had been hospitalized since June, 1961.

Funeral will be held at 2:30 p.m. Friday in the Second Baptist Church with the Rev. Lee Fields, pastor of the East Side Baptist Church, and the Rev. Charles Bush, pastor of Second Baptist, officiating. Burial will be in Alameda Cemetery under direction of Killingsworth Funeral Home.

Born Oct. 28, 1869, in Mississippi, she was the former Emma Frances Melton and married Jim A. Green Dec. 20, 1888, in Itawamba County, Miss. He died in 1921.

Survivors are two half-brothers, Luther Melton and Bird Melton, both of Odessa; one sister, Mrs. Sula Walton of Ranger; a number of nieces and nephews.
