

Viona Lee Adams - Olden Woman Dies in Ranger Hospital

RANGER (RNS) — Viona Lee Adams, 57, a resident of Olden for the past 18 years and of Eastland County all her life, died at 8:05 am. Thursday in the Ranger General Hospital after a lengthy illness.

She had been hospitalized for the past 13 days.

Born Sept. 9, 1905, in Salem community, she was the former Viona Lee Revels. She married John Adams Jan. 25, 1929 in Eastland. He died in 1958.

Funeral will be held at 2:30 p.m. Friday at the Killingsworth Funeral Chapel, with H. M. Motsinger, minister of Church of Christ in Olden, officiating. Burial will be in Alameda Cemetery.
