

## **Desdemona Rites for Mrs. Lane**

GORMAN - Funeral for long-time Desdemona resident Mrs. Beulah Florine Lane, 90, was to be held at 2:30 p.m. Tuesday in the First Baptist Church at Desdemona with the Rev. Derrell Dosey, pastor, and Andy Moore, minister of the Church of Christ at Gorman, officiating.
