

Thomas Fox Dies at 71

RANGER (RNS) — Thomas M. Fox collapsed and died of a heart attack on Main Street here Thursday about 11:45 a.m. while he was changing a flat tire on his car. He was 71.

An assistant operator for Lone Star Producing Co. for 31 years, Mr. Fox retired in March 1952. He was a lifetime resident of the county.

He had lived in Ranger since 1917. He was born in the Chaney community of Eastland County on March 3, 1887. He married Dora Jane Sharp on Sept. 29, 1906, in Alameda. Mr. Fox belonged to the East Side Baptist Church here.

Funeral will be held Saturday at 2 p.m. in the First Baptist Church of Ranger, with the Rev. K.C. Edmonds, pastor of the East Side church officiating. Burial will be in Alameda Cemetery, under direction of Killingsworth Funeral Home.

He is survived by his wife; two sons, J.W. of San Antonio, Thomas Jr, of Cortez, Colo.; three daughters, Mrs. Jack Williams, Mrs. Clyde Fisher and Mrs. Tom Williams, all of Ranger; two brothers, C. V. Fox of Fort Worth and G.L. of Andrews; 13 grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.
