

Pioneer Runnels Resident Dies

BALLINGER, Jan. 14— (Spl) — Mrs. Price Jane Richardson, 71, resident of Runnels county since 1907, died at 1:30 a.m. Tuesday at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Mary Davidson, in the Valley Creek community near here. She had been in failing health for the past year.

Funeral services will be held at 2:30 p.m. Wednesday at the First Baptist church of Chaney, Tex., with the Rey. Willie Skaggs officiating. Burial will be in the Chaney cemetery, Agnew funeral home of Ballinger and Higginbotham funeral home of Chaney are in charge of arrangements.
