RANGER—Funeral for Mrs. Dora Jane Fox, 80, a resident of Ranger and Eastland counties most of her life, will be at 2 p.m. Wednesday in Eastside Baptist Church with the Rev. Lee Fields, pastor, and the Rev. K. C. Edmonds, retired Baptist minister, officiating.

Mrs. Fox died at 7:50 a.m. Monday in Western Manor Nursing Home after a long illness.
