

William Phelix Allen - William Allen, 89, Dies In Frederick

FREDRICK, Okla. (Special) - William Phelix Allen, 89, died Friday in Tillman County Memorial Hospital following an extended illness.

Services were set tentatively for Monday in Gish Memorial Chapel here with Rev. Mart Hardin, First Baptist pastor, officiating. Burial will be in Alameda Cemetery southeast of Ranger.

Allen was born March 12, 1877 in Haralson County, Georgia. He came to Tillman County In 1924 from Wichita Falls, where he had resided eight and one-half years. He was a retired carpenter. Allen was a member of the Baptist Church.

His first wile, the former Emmie Stephen, died in 1902. He married Mattie Lee Perrin April 5, 1909. She died in 1961.

Survivors include two daughters, Mrs. Galama Smith, Renton, Wash., and Mrs. William Prigmore, Barstow, Calif.; one son, R. H. Allen, Midwest City, Okla.; and seven grandchildren.
