Charles E. Dean Funeral Is Held

ROTAN - Funeral for Charles E. Dean, 78, retired Fisher County farmer, was at 10 am. Monday in Weathersbee Chapel in Rotan with the Rev. Ross Payne, pastor of Cottonflat Baptist Church in Midland, officiating.

He was assisted by Wardell Halliburton, minister of Roby Church of Christ. Burial was to be at 4 p.m. Monday at Alameda Cemetery in Eastland County under the direction of Weathersbee Funeral Home.

He died at 10:45 a.m. Sunday in Callan Hospital in Rotan following a three day illness.

Mr. Dean was born Sept. 21, 1890, in Mesquite and was married Dec. 26, 1927, to Ova L. Hamilton in Eastland. They moved to Fisher County in 1932 to farm in the Roby area. He was a member of the Baptist church.
