

Mattie Lee Allen - Ranger Rites Set For Mrs. Allen, 76

RANGER — Funeral for Mrs. Mattie Lee Allen, 76, former Ranger resident, was held at 10 am. Friday in Frederick, Okla., with a second service to be held at 10 a.m. Saturday at Killingsworth Funeral Chapel here. The Rev. Frank Brooks, pastor of the Second Baptist Church here, will officiate at the funeral here.

Burial will be in Alameda Cemetery, south of Ranger.

Mrs. Allen, born Jan. 25, 1884, in Bradley County, Tenn., died Wednesday in Frederick. She came to Ranger at the age of 10 and was married here May 9, 1909, to W. P. Allen. They moved to Frederick in 1924.

She was a member of the Baptist Church.

Survivors include the husband; a son, Robert of Oklahoma City; two daughters, Mrs. Willie Trimore of Texas and Mrs. Glema Smith of Washington; two brothers, Henry Perrin of Ranger and Carl Perrin of Denver City, and a sister, Mrs. Virgie Lee of Ranger.
