RANGER (RNS) — Henry P. Perrin, 73, a resident of the Chaney community for 71 years, died at 5:05 a.m. Friday in Ranger General Hospital.

Funeral will be Sunday at 2:30p.m. in Killingsworth's Funeral Home Chapel with the Rev. Lee Fields, pastor of East Side Baptist Church, officiating. Burial will be in Alameda Cemetery.
