KERRVILLE — Graveside services for Earl F. Burris.Jr., 74, of Kerrville, who died Monday in a Kerrville hospital, will be Wednesday at 1 p.m. in Alameda Cemetery near Ranger.

Born Aug. 23, 1920 in Ranger, Mr. Burris had been a resident of Kerrville for four years, formerly residing in Sweetwater from 1980 to 1990.
