MINERAL WELLS — Fred D. Clark, 75, of Mineral Wells passed away Monday, March 24, 2014.

Fred was born May 30, 1938, in Gorman and was raised on a farm south of Blanket in Brown County. He attended Blanket High School and then graduated from Texas A&M University in 1960 with a degree in electrical engineering, serving honorably as an officer in the Corp of Cadets.
