Heart Attack Fatal to Man at Ranger

RANGER, March 17 (RNS) - Winford Gilmer Gammill, 62, of Fort Worth died here Monday morning of a heart attack.

Funeral services are to be held in Killingsworth Funeral Home Chapel at 2 p.m. Wednesday with burial to be in Alameda Cemetery directed by Killingsworth. The Rev. H. D. Blair, Baptist minister, is to officiate.

Pallbearers are to be Lloyd Bruce, Bud Blackwell, Howard Frasier, and Ernest Calvert, all of Ranger, and Floyd Crawley and M. A. Ables, both of Eastland.

Survivors include a sister, Mrs. Estella M. Duncan, of Eastland; two brothers, Herman Gammill of Rochester, and C. A. Gammill of Lubbock.

Mr. Gammill was born March 19, 1890, in Cecil, Ark, and moved to Eastland County in 1905. He taught in rural schools and Eastland and Stephens Counties. In 1942 he moved to Fort Worth where he had been employed for the last 10 years as a hotel clerk.
