## B. F. Weekes Rites Held at Ranger

RANGER, Aug. 26 (RNS) — Funeral was held Thursday afternoon at the First Christian Church in Ranger for Benjamin Franklin Weekes, 70, who died at his home on Spring Road at 4:30 a.m. Wednesday. The Rev. Don Fordyce, pastor, officiated.

Mr. Weekes, a retired carpenter, was born June 24, 1884 in San Augustine County, Texas. He came to Eastland County in 1889 with his parents.
