

Mrs. Smith Rites Today

STAMFORD (RNS) — Mrs. Lula C. Smith, 78, died at 1:30 a.m. Monday in the Stamford Memorial Hospital after an illness of six years.

Funeral will be Tuesday at 10 a.m. at the Kinney Funeral Chapel with the Rev. Roy Mosley, pastor of the Calvary Baptist Church, officiating. Burial will be at 3 p.m. at the Alameda Cemetery south of Ranger.

She was born Lula Cooper Dec. 26, 1888, in Strickland, Ark., and in 1912 married D. T. Smith in Oklahoma. He died Dec. 6, 1938. They moved to Haskell County in 1924 and to Stamford in 1939. She lived at N. Swenson St. and was a member of the Baptist church.
