Wreck Victim's Funeral Today

Helen Joyce Thornhill, 42, 1205 Alameda, will be conducted at 4 p.m. today in the First Baptist Church at Desdemona. Burial is to be in Alameda Cemetery under direction of Arrington-Hamner Funeral Home of Eastland

Mrs. Thornhill died early Tuesday of injuries she suffered Monday when her car missed a sharp curve on a country road west of Creede, Colo., and overturned four times down a steep hill.

The Thornhills left Odessa Saturday night for a two-week vacation in Colorado.

She has been employed as a clerk at the Dunlap Department Store here for the past 10 years, Her husband is a pumper for Great Western Drilling Co.

She was born Sept. 26, 1925, in Eastland, and had lived at Terminal about eight years before moving to Odessa seven years ago. Mrs. Thornhill was a member of the Baptist Church.
