## **Jack Lee Dies at 61 in Temple**

EASTLAND (RNS) - E. H. (Jack) Lee, 61, of Rt. 2 Olden, died at 4 a.m. Saturday in Scott & White Hospital in Temple after a four-month illness.

Funeral will be held at 4 p.m. Sunday in the Arrington-Hamner Funeral Chapel in Eastland, the Rev. Bob Farrell, pastor of Olden Baptist Church, officiating, assisted by Gary Beauchamp, Church of Christ minister in Ranger.

Burial will be in Alameda Cemetery, south of Ranger.

Mr. Lee had been a resident of Olden for three years. He was a farmer and formerly had lived in the Morton Valley Community north of Eastland. He had lived most of his life in Eastland County.

He was born Oct. 19, 1905 in Erath County. He married Nellie Seay, July 24, 1926 in Eastland.

Survivors are five sons, Carlton, Donald and Edward, all of McCombs, Miss., Kenneth of Sweetwater and Tommie of Fort Wolters at Mineral Wells; two daughters, Mrs. F. H. Molloy of Farmington, N.
