Charles Lee Love, 23, to be Buried at Ranger this Week

Charles Lee Love, 23, an employee of the Big Lake Oil Company and a resident of Texon for the last six months, died at a hospital there Sunday night at 7:20 o'clock following an illness of only four days.

Love was graduated from Howard Payne College and was an important member of the '28 and '29 football squads, it was learned. He came from Desdemona, Texas.

The body was brought overland from Texon by Johnson's and will be forwarded on the 9:50 o'clock Santa Fe tonight to Ranger for burial near there Wednesday.

Survivors include the widow of six months; the parents, Mr. and Mrs. W. A. Love of Ranger; two sisters; Mrs. H. P. Perry and Miss Lillie Love of Ranger, and seven brothers, Dave of Brownwood, John of Wink, George, Robert, Melva, Jack, and Herbert, all of Ranger.
