ODESSA - R.M. Love, 85, died Wednesday at his residence.

Services will be at 2 p.m. today at Sixth and Jackson Church of Christ with Larry Roberts officiating.

Graveside services will be at 3 p.m. Sunday at Alameda Cemetery south of Ranger, directed by Frank W. Wilson Funeral Directors.

Mr. Love was born in Ranger on July 21, 1905. He married Fannye Underwood Sept 13, 1931 in Ranger. They moved to Odessa in 1936 from Ranger. He had been owner of R.M. Love Mobile Homes in Odessa, also owned Love Insurance Agency and had been involved in real estate investments.

He also owned a barber and beauty shop, Sanitary Food Store and a loan company. He was a member of Sixth and Jackson Church of Christ where he served as a deacon.

He was named to Who's Who of the Southwest as an independent businessman and served in the U.S. Army during World War II.

Survivors include his wife, Fannye Love of Odessa; a son, Don Love of Odessa; three brothers, Melva Love of Gorman, Jack Love of Ranger and Herbert Love of Odessa; and two grandchildren.
