Hugo Schmidt, 83, of 409 Santos died at 8:15 a.m. Wednesday in Happy Haven Nursing Home after a lengthy illness. Services will be at 10 a.m. Friday in First Christian Church.

Dr. Chris Diebel, pastor, will officiate. Burial will be at 2 p.m. in Alameda Cemetery in Eastland County, directed by Elliott-Hamil Funeral Home, 542 Hickory.

Born Aug. 26, 1895, in Mason, he married Roxie Ethyle Reid July 16, 1922, in Sweetwater. The couple moved to Abilene from Sweetwater in March 1927.

He was a retired shipping clerk and had worked for Bowman Biscuit Co. which is now the Keebler Co., for 29 years, and for Wooten Grocery Co. for 25 years.

Mr. Schmidt was a combat veteran of World War I. He was a member of VFW Post 2012 of Abilene.

He was a member of First Christian Church.
