Belyeu, Mamie Vowell - Mrs. Belyeu Rites Slated at Ranger

RANGER (RNS) — Funeral for Mrs. Mamie Vowell Belyeu, 74, a native of Taylor County, will be held at 2 pm, Saturday at Killingsworth Funeral Chapel with Lonnie Branam, minister of the Eden Church of Christ, officiating.

Burial will be in Alameda Cemetery south of Ranger.

Mrs. Belyeu, an Eastland County resident most of her life, died Thursday at the home of a son in Sundown, Claude B. Belyeu, with whom she had lived since Feb. 7.

Born Oct. 14, 1886 in Taylor County, she married Charlie C. Belyeu Sept 18, 1906 in Desdemona. Mr. Belyeu died Feb 22, 1957. Mrs. Belyeu was a member of the Church of Christ.

Surviving are two sons, Claude of Sundown and Jessie C. of Ranger; a daughter, Mrs. O. B. Ables of Ranger; a sister, Mrs. Harvey Belyeu of Dexter, N.M., four grandchildren and two great grandchildren.
