

Longtime Alameda Resident is Dead

RANGER, Dec, 14 (RNS)—Mrs. E. R. Underwood, 91, longtime resident of the Alameda community near here, died at the home of one of her step-sons in Ranger at 4 a.m. Saturday.

Born Aug. 21, 1866, in Illinois, she married E.R. Underwood in Florence, Tex. in 1904. The couple moved to Eastland County in 1908 from Bell County. Mr. Underwood died in 1946. She was a member of the Church of Christ.

Funeral will be Sunday at 4 p.m. at the Alameda Cemetery, with O. G. Lanier officiating. Burial will be under direction of the Killingsworth Funeral Home.

Survivors include two step-sons, W. R. and Walter Underwood, both of Ranger; 10 grandchildren, 28 great-grandchildren and 10 great-great-grandchildren.
